Sugarcane Production, Price Woes Weigh On Ethanol Blending Targets

The ethanol blending programme (EBP) is progressing with year-to-date blending levels at 11.8% (highest ever). While the government has reiterated its target of 20% EBP by 2025, concerns over sugarcane and sugar production, and an increase in grain prices are likely to push the target by a couple years. Estimates say that sugar-based ethanol production capacity of 8.5bn litre, and grain-based capacity of 3.5bn litre is in place — sufficient to achieve 15% blending over 2 years
